## Canada: Keep your Promise to Refugees in Uganda

Dear Minister Bibeau

Uganda hosts over 900,000 refugees from South Sudan who are fleeing serious human rights abuses including targeted killings of civilians, torture, and sexual violence, including rape.

Uganda has welcomed refugees. However, the international community is failing to support Uganda. The United Nation's appeal for support to Uganda for 2017 is underfunded. Basic needs, including access to food, water, sanitation, health care and shelter not being met.

## I urge you to

- Ensure that Canada lives up to its March 2017 commitment to provide the emergency humanitarian assistance to UN agencies and humanitarian organizations in response to the crisis.
- Provide a further generous financial commitment towards fulfilling the financial needs faced by UN agencies and the Ugandan government; and
- Encourage other governments to follow Canada's lead
