

BACKGROUND

Honduras has become one of the most dangerous countries in the world to defend land, territory and the environment.

Berta Cáceres, leader and co-founder of the Civic Council of Popular and Indigenous Organizations of Honduras (COPINH), was murdered in her home in La Esperanza on March 2, 2016. Since then, other members of her organization have been killed in Honduras. Arbitrary detentions, death threats, attacks and killings continue against other defenders of land, water and Indigenous rights, amidst near total impunity.
