




MEXICO: TAKE ACTION FOR THE MISSING

Enrique Peña Nieto, President of Mexico:

From Canada, we share deep concern that reported disappearances in Mexico have surpassed 35,000. Emblematic among them is the enforced disappearance of 43 students from a teachers college in Ayotzinapa.

We urge you to take effective action to confront this crisis by:

- Ensuring full implementation of the Law on Disappearance and the National Search Commission, with adequate funding and human resources, as well as the active participation of representatives of the Movement for Our Disappeared in Mexico.
- Ensuring creation of the Special Truth and Justice Investigative Commission into the disappearance of 43 students of Ayotzinapa, as ordered by a federal court in June 2018, as well as implementation of the recommendations of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights in its March 2018 report on the investigation into the disappeared students of Ayotzinapa.
