To President Martin Vizcarra,

Indigenous communities in Cuninico and Espinar are suffering a terrifying health crisis as their water has been contaminated with toxic metals and other harmful chemicals. Peruvian authorities have failed to protect their right to health and a healthy environment.

We call on you to implement emergency health plans in these regions without delay, which should include providing the communities with access to safe drinking water. We also call on you to identify and control the sources of toxins in their water.
